In August we started our campaign for business donations for our AFC Silent Auction contribution. We procured donations in excess of \$1100 and donated three separate baskets to the auction. 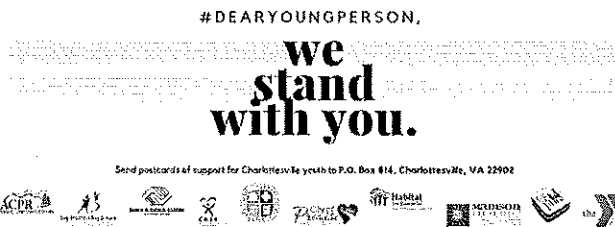
