Dr. Marjan Mazza

CEO of Pari & Associates Inc.



Dr. Mazza has 35 years of professional experience in the Aviation industry. She has held the positions of Assistant Aviation Director at Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport, Chairperson of Aviation Department at Miami-Dade College, and Federal Officer at the US DOT, where she had regulatory and fiduciary oversight of 600 airports.

The Broward County Board of County Commissioners issued a proclamation designating Wednesday, November 4, 1998, as Marjan Mazza Appreciation day. Dr. Mazza also earned the Broward County Administrator's Performance Excellence Award, Broward County Historical Commission's Historian's Award, and recognition from the Naval Air Station Fort Lauderdale Historical Association.

Dr. Mazza established an endowed scholarship at PSC in 2015. The PSC board of trustees has renamed the BAS degree program the " Marjan Mazza Bachelor of Applied Science in Business and Management program.

"Dr. Mazza holds a Bachelor's of Science and Master's degrees in Business Administration from Embry Riddle Aeronautical University and a Doctoral in Business Administration specializing in Organization Leadership from Northcentral University.

Dr. Mazza is currently a professor at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

Teniadé Broughton

Pensacola City Councilwoman

Elected in 2020, Teniadé Broughton is the councilmember for District 5 and a longtime resident of Pensacola's Woodland Heights neighborhood.

Teniadé is a proud graduate of Booker T. Washington High School, the University of West Florida, and Florida A&M University. Deeply active in the community, Teniadé is a seventh-generation Pensacolian and member of Allen Chapel AME Church, the president of the John Sunday Society, chairperson of the Escambia County Equal Justice Initiative, a member of the Gallery Night Pensacola Board, Pensacola Bicentennial Celebration Committee, Junior League of Pensacola, and a local historian specializing in Pensacola's African American History.

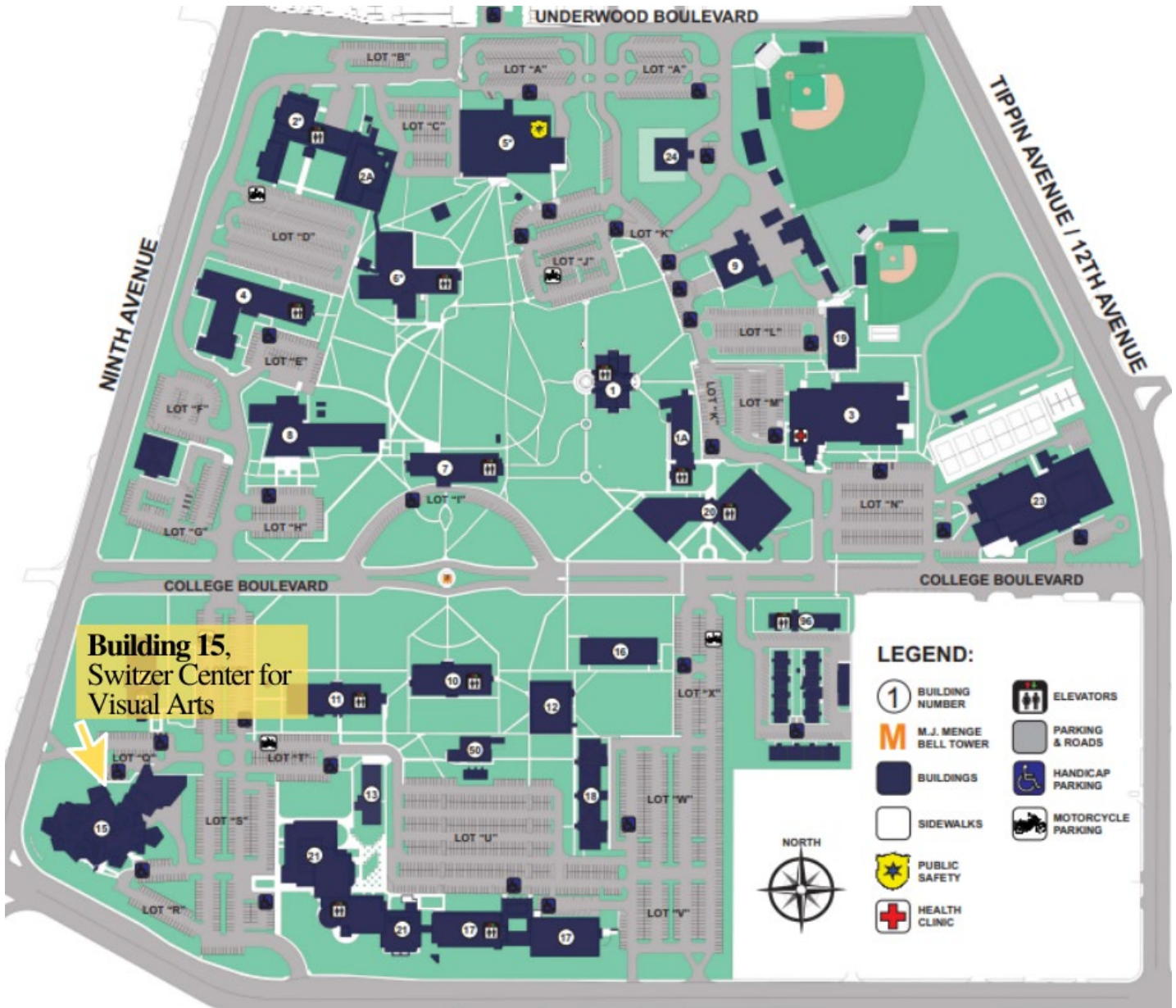
