Dr. Ed Meadows congratulated Mr. Michael Brawer for his recent recognition for his work on campus safety.

Dr. Ed Meadows referred to the handouts entitled <u>Conference Report on House Bill 5001</u> and <u>2016-17 Implementing Bill.</u>

Chancellor Pumariega referred to the handout entitled <u>The Florida College System-Summary Budget Side-by-Side</u> and <u>5 Year FCS Program Fund Summary</u>. She reported there is \$15.4 in recurring special projects and \$8.5 million in non-recurring special projects. She added there is \$10 million in industry certification.

She reported the Governor has 14 days to sign the budget.

She reported HB 7029 is a train bill that includes performance based language.

Dr. Ed Meadows expressed the importance of readiness for the 2017 legislative session. The legislative agenda and legislative budget request will be discussed at the June meeting.

Ms. Victoria Hernandez reported the textbook access affordability is on the way to the Governor to be signed. She added a complete list of bills that passed will be emailed to the presidents.

Ms. Victoria Hernandez thanked the lobbyists, Ballard Partners, Division staff and Dr. Judy Bilsky for their hard work during session.
