## 4.0 Report of the Chancellor, The Division of Florida Colleges

Chancellor Hanna reported there will be a State Board of Education workshop on Florida College System issues on November 17 at Seminole State College, Heathrow Center.

He reminded the presidents the agreements with the collegiate high schools are due at the end of December.

The Chancellor reported the Auditor is inquiring about dual enrollment and articulation agreements.

The Disabilities Task Force will be meeting November 14<sup>th</sup>.

Chancellor Hanna reported on the third year of eligibility in athletics. He stated those colleges with baccalaureate degrees would have a limit of two years of eligibility. He also added a change in legislation would be needed in order to have a third year of eligibility.

<u>Action:</u> Upon a motion by Dr. John Holdnak and a second by Dr. Jackson Sasser, the Council of Presidents voted to not pursue a third year of eligibility in athletics was approved without objection.
