REGULARLY NEEDED ITEMS:

- Toothpaste, full size
- Toothbrushes
- Deodorant
- Bars of soap, full size
- Body wash
- Shaving cream/gel
- Razors
- Shampoo
- Lotion
- Toilet paper
- Paper towels
- Laundry detergent
- Boxers/briefs, all sizes
- T-shirts, all sizes
- Socks, all sizes
- Shower shoes, all sizes (especially 9, 10, 11, 12)
- Twin sheet sets
- Pillows
- Towels/face cloths
- Gift cards that can be utilized for random minor clothing needs – i.e. belts, sneakers, etc.

Below are items that we regularly need for the homeless veterans and their families that we house in the community:

- Queen sheet sets
- Female hygiene products
- Female versions of any of the above products that are “gendered” like deodorant, razors, etc.
- Gift cards that can be used for food
- Gas cards
